

St Andrew's Church Taunton Message from Father Robin—Vicar

A few weeks ago, Sue and I went to see a filmed production of the 1970's rock opera Jesus Christ Superstar by Andrew Lloyd-Webber and Tim Rice. I remember being taken on a school trip by my RE teacher to see the show at the Palace Theatre in London in about 1976. I bought the LP soon afterwards, although I rarely play it now. Yet those tunes came back to me as if it were vesterday!

In the scene of Jesus' second trial before Pontius Pilate, the lyrics draw on John's Gospel in which Pilate asks Jesus, "What is truth?" But what is truth? Is truth a changing law? We both have truths. Are mine the same as yours? Good question. In this age often dubbed the "posttruth age" in which leaders make assertions that are at best nuanced and at worst downright untrue. A world where truth is defined by worldly power. Putin's ^{*}special military operation" (war!) comes to mind, as does Trump's social media site, "Truth Social." History records a vast procession of powerful men who have an uneasy relationship with the truth.

Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father but by me." In other words, Jesus lives a deeper truth than mere naked power can offer. It is the way of the suffering servant upon whom we reflect this Passiontide and as we make our annual Holy Week journey. It is only by following this path in humility that we shall truly meet God.

When Mary met Jesus at the Empty Tomb, she came face to face with the deepest truth of all, that, as St Paul put it, "nothing, not even death shall separate us from the love of God."




